

## Butcher Block Leg Pattern

The legs for the butcher block table were purchased from an online supplier. The classic profile works well and blends in nicely with the design of the project.

If you would prefer to turn your own legs, the drawing below gives you measurements that match the profile of the leg that was used. Also, on the following three pages is a full-size pattern. After printing them, assemble the three pages by aligning the red registration lines to each other and tape them together. From there you can use the pattern to make a hardboard template to follow while turning the parts. Or fashion it to fit a lathe duplicator.
