

spokeshave Sharpening Jig



When sharpening a spokeshave blade, the goal is no different than with any other edge tool. First, you want to flatten and polish the back side of the blade. Next, you hone the 25° bevel to a razor-sharp edge. The problem is that without a good way

to get a grip on the narrow blade and its protruding posts, this second step can be troublesome.

ADJUSTABLE HONING GUIDE. The solution to the problem is the adjustable honing guide you see in the photos here and in

the drawing below. It does what your fingers can't do and snugly grips the blade at just the right angle. And putting a fine polish on the cutting edge is a simple matter.



▲ A pair of finish washers hold the blade tightly in the jig allowing you to easily hone the cutting edge.
